

Method for Faster Use of BOF Web Site

Web site update

Two visible modifications have recently been made to the British Orienteering web site that you should be aware of:

1. The menu system has been modified to work on non-Flash machines and should load and work quicker on non-broadband modems. This modification also means that it should now work on pda etc.
If you are using Internet Explorer and want to see the non-Flash version turn off Flash by going to 'Tools', click 'Manage Add-ons', click 'Enable or Disable Add-ons', select 'Shockwave Flash Object' from the list, click 'Disable' button below in settings and then click 'Ok'. You will be asked to restart Internet Explorer but don't have to. To re-enable Flash follow the same process but select the add-on and select 'Enable' in settings.
2. If you select 'News' from the main, top of the page, buttons you will be taken to a page that contains 'Major Topics' rather than the News Archive. We will be using this page to inform you about current major topics and to perhaps include queries from members along with our responses. This should enable us to improve the level of communication with members about major topics of interest.
3. A new page for Embargoed Areas has also been added as requested by Event Organisers. The page can be found [here](#).

It is worth noting that there have been high priority modifications made to the web site throughout the period since it was rolled-out, however most of these significant changes have been behind the scenes rather than visible to the public and member view of the web site.
